Survey to gauge interest in other competition formats

At our 2014 AGM it was decided to conduct a survey of suggestions for new competition formats.

After careful consideration suggestions received were condensed into the following:

1. Mens/Womens Doubles (not mixed) – played at weekends during the Summer season
2. Mens/Womens Doubles with an added Singles leg (not mixed) – played at weekends during the Summer season
3. Mixed Doubles – played at weekends during the Summer season
4. Change Summer League from six players to four
5. Change Summer League format to mixed pairs only

n.b. suggestions 4 and 5, would replace the current Summer League format.

Other suggestions were not considered within the current scope of the League.

Please will you discuss these suggestions with your Club Committee and come to the meeting with your level of interest in any of the above formats and a reasonably firm commitment on behalf of your club that you would enter one or more teams in any of the above.
